

Declaration to RoHS-conformity and WEEE-guideline

Basis and Requirement

The RoHS- and WEEE-guidelines are valid in the area of the European Union. In view of environmental pollution, the guidelines regulate within the EU the launch in the market and the waste disposal of electrical and electronic equipment.

The **EU-guideline 2011/65/EU** of June 8th, 2011, extended in 2023 EU-guideline 2022/1632, **RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances)**, regulates among other things the concentration of lead, mercury, cadmium, 6-valency chrome and bromide flame-protective-substances (PBB and PBDE) of electronic instruments.

In the context of the RoHS-guideline the **EU-guideline 2012/19/EU, dated July 4th, 2012 and 2018/849/EU, dated May 30th, 2018, WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment)** has been passed. Prior goal of the WEEE is to avoid, reduce, reuse as well as to recycle old electrical and electronic instruments.

The regulations of the WEEE-guideline are included in the German law “**Elektro- und Elektronikgerätegesetz**” of **March 16th, 2005 (current version, dated December 8th, 2022)**.

Declaration to RoHS-conformity

HEITRONICS Infrarot Messtechnik GmbH operates worldwide. We are conscious of the environmental protection and the conservation of the natural resources. For this reason, we already committed ourselves from the first version of the guideline to guaranteeing that our products comply with the EU-guideline RoHS.

The products of HEITRONICS Infrarot Messtechnik GmbH are assigned to **category 9 (Control and monitoring equipment)** of the RoHS-guideline. According to this they will be impacted under the RoHS. Our company is proud to be able to declare conformity to the RoHS-guideline.

Declaration to WEEE-guideline

According to the WEEE-guideline, the products of HEITRONICS Infrarot Messtechnik GmbH can be categorized/assigned to category Small Equipment. . This categorization is also valid for the national "Elektro- Elektronikgerätegesetz" which combines the two guidelines WEEE and RoHS in one German law.

According to this law, HEITRONICS Infrarot Messtechnik GmbH is registered at **ear (Stiftung Elektro-Altgeräte Register)**.

Characterization of products

Our products are not subject to labeling according to the regulations of the "Elektro- und Elektronikgerätegesetz" and the WEEE-Guideline. Conformity to the RoHS-guideline is confirmed in our manuals.
